The Hive 116 House Rules

- 1. Items that are available for all Coworking Space users not solely for you.
 - This includes snacks, drinks, office supplies, and more. Be considerate and remember this is a shared space.
- 2. If you spill something coffee, tea, whatever clean it up.
- 3. When you're having a conversation, be considerate and try to keep the volume down.
 - Please do not have speaker phone conversations. Utilize headphones.
 - o If your conversation will be particularly long, plan to utilize the phone booth.
 - We recognize this is an office space, so phone calls and meetings are going to happen.
 However, please be considerate of others while you complete those calls and meetings.
- 4. Don't slam doors.
- 5. Flush the toilet once you've finished.
- 6. If there's a plumbing issue, please reach out to our Management Team immediately!
- 7. Fill the printer with paper if it's out. Especially if you're the one responsible for it being out of paper.
 - You can find additional paper on the shelf to the right of the printer. If we're out of paper, please let our Management Team know immediately!
- 8. Don't eat someone else's food or drink their beverages.
- 9. Throw out the leftovers! If you're not going to eat them, don't leave them in the fridge.
 - A general rule of thumb: don't leave anything in there for more than 5 days
- 10. Keep the ringer on your cell phone low or on vibrate.
 - Headphones will help with this if you need a higher ringer volume!
- 11. Phone calls and virtual meetings should NOT be conducted on speaker unless you are inside your private office with the door closed. Otherwise, please utilize headphones.
- 12. If you're at a shared table, be mindful of how wide you spread out. Try to keep your belongings on your end of the table/space.
- 13. Belongings should not be left unattended in the common spaces.
- 14. Be friendly.
- 15. Don't move furniture.
- 16. Break down your boxes and place them in the recycling bin outside.
- 17. Don't readjust the temperature lower than 68 or higher than 72.
 - o If you notice the temperature is unusually hot or cold, reach out to our Management Team.
- 18. Throw business to your fellow coworkers! We're all in this together!
- 19. If someone looks like they are busy and concentrating on something, they probably are and do not want to be interrupted.
- 20. If you are bringing a visitor, please make sure you purchase a Day Pass for him/her.
 - Exception: If you are a Hive 116 Member and a visitor is coming in to meet with you for an hour or less, a Day Pass is not required.
- 21. All visitors must be accompanied by a member at all times.
- 22. Help keep your coworking space nice and clean by picking up after yourself and your space.
- 23. Read your emails from The Hive Management Team.
